## BLACK JACK

## Hand Value:

The hand with highest total wins as long as it doesn't exceed 21. A hand with a higher total than 21 is said bust or have too many. Cards 2 through 10 are worth their face value, and face cards are worth 10 . An ace value is 11 unless this would cause the player to bust in which case it is worth 1. A two card hand of 21 is called a :black jack" or a natural, and is an automatic winner(unless the dealer has blackjack as well, in which case the hand is a "push").

## Objective and Winning:

The aim is to have a hand value that is closer to 21 than that of dealer, without going over 21 i.e. busting. Other players at the table are of no concern. Note that if the player busts he loses, even if the dealer also busts. If both the player and the dealer have the same point value it is called a "push", and neither player nor dealer wins the hand. Each player has an independent game with the dealer, so it is possible for the dealer to lose to some players and beat the others in same round.

## Deal:

Cards will be dealt with 3 decks the dealer gives two cards to each player including himself. One of the dealers two cards are face-up and all players can see it players get their cards face down. Both the cards of the player are face-up.

## Player Decisions:

The player's options for playing his or her hand are:

- HIT: Take another card
- STAND: Take no more cards
- DOUBLE: Double the wager, take exactly one more card and then stand, you can double your original bet after you receive your first two cards only
- SPLIT: Double the wager and have each card be the first card in a new hand. This option is available only when both cards have same rank
The player's turn is over after deciding to stand, doubling down to take a single card, or busting. He may take as many hits as he likes otherwise
Note: We don't offer surrender or insurance options to keep the game simple for you to play.


## Dealers Play:

If the dealers face up card is 10 valued or an ace, the dealer checks his hole card to see if he has black jack. This check occurs before any of the players play. If the dealer has blackjack all players lose their initial bets, except players who also have black jack, who push.
After all players have finished making their decisions and played their hands, the dealer then reveals his hidden hole card and plays the hand. Dealer keeps hitting until he gets at least 17.

## Payoffs and limits on betting:

A player with a black jack is paid 3:2 on his bet. Bets are normally paid at the odds 1:1.
A player can carry at most 250 MB on first day and 500 MB on remaining days to the table. These amts will be double for executive class players.
