## <u>4<sup>th</sup> Special Meeting of the Students' Senate (2017-18): Minutes</u>

The 2017-18/4<sup>th</sup> Special Meeting of the Students' Senate was held on 24<sup>th</sup> October, 2017 in the Senate Hall, SAC. The meeting was called to order by the Chairperson, Students' Senate at 8:34 PM.

Item No. 2 Announcements and Remarks, if any

- The Chairperson, Students' Senate announced that there will be a new OARS system for the UG and PG students in the next registration period. This will be done in two phases.
- The General Secretary, Media and Cultural Affairs, announced that the first IIT SPAN (Student's Presence Across the Nation) was held in IIT Kanpur from 30<sup>th</sup> September to 1<sup>st</sup> October. Various issues were discussed such as the Inter IIT Cultural Meet being held from 28<sup>th</sup> December and waiving of the minimum balance in SBI accounts for IIT students.

The Senate pointed out that there is a need of a procedure in place for the transaction regarding the proposed buffer amount. The Senate also recommended that the Chief Medical Officer should be a member of the panel approving the transactions. The Senate in principle accepted the policy as presented.

- The CoSHA Convener remarked that there is currently no HEC in Hall of Residence 2 which has led to various problems in messing. The Senate suggested that the CoSHA Convener takes charge of the hall, and call nominations inside the hall for forming a committee to assist him in hall related issues . The Senate also decided to forward the request of the CoSHA convener for nominating a new HEC to the Warden of Hall of Residence 2.





- The Chairperson, Students' Senate remarked that a Gymkhana Server was being set up. It would have a mailing list, nominations portal, SSF Portal, and Club and Hobby Group material.
- The Chairperson also remarked that the contact list currently available on the Senate website is outdated. He requested Senators to submit their updated information in a form which would be circulated.
- A senator enquired about the steady decline of IIT Kanpur's national and international rankings. The Overall Coordinator, ARC clarified that wrong and outdated data is being sent to the MHRD which is resulting in the below par ranks. The Senate directed the Overall Coordinator, ARC to look in the matter and revert back to the Senate.
