The Draft Minutes had been circulated by the Chairman along with the Agenda and were presented by him for the consideration of the Senate.

The Minutes of the Meetings were confirmed by the Students' Senate without any changes.

Item No. 2	Announcements and Remarks, if any

1.) The President, Students' Gymkhana raised concern over cases of ragging and asked all the senators to spread awareness to curb the problem.

2.) President said that in the recent past, the Students' Gymkhana forwards proposal related to space and infrastructure. In most circumstances such proposals could not get clearance from the competent authority. Hence he requested a student (president, SG or Chairman, SS) should be a member of the ISPAC committee.

3.) President also requested Workshop for the National School of Drama should be given space in the Gymkhana calendar.

4.) Efforts should be made for sending more people to the UN Leadership Symposium.





5.) The President, Students' Gymkhana requested the GRC to accommodate space for Director, Prof. Indranil Manna for taking an infomal session with freshers in each hall.

6.) UGMRC (UG Manual Revision Committee) currently consist of student representative as Aditya Gupta who has passed out, hence the students' senate as to nominate someone soon. This announcement was made by President, SG.

7.) For the Second International Conference on Entrepreneurship and Health care, 3 students out of 5 of those who turned up for the interview were selected. The selection was made by the nomination committee along with Dr. Deepu Philip, but the response from students was too low. This announcement was made by Chairman, SS.

8.) General Secretary, Cultural Council Spic Macay got cancelled due to some personal problems of the artist.

9.) A show cause notice will be sent to the Antaragni team for publicizing International Beer Day on their facebook page.

10.) It was recommended that before publication for any event was made through the media, permission should be taken from the competent authority. It was also suggested to involve COFA for finding facts regarding the disclosure of the names of few star celebrities attending Antaragni'13 by the local newspaper, Kanpur Times.

11.) Secretary, Student Senate Sandarsh Pandey (12611) has given his resignation from the post.

12.) Taekwondo club coordinator, Parul Sharma has given her resignation from the post.

13.) Impressions' 13 dates has been postponed to 16th October'13 from the previous 8th September'13.
