Ratification Rules for EC members

- Most of the work of Election Council during the elections consists of vigilance and intelligence
- Ratification of the EC members interferes in this work and makes it hard
- So, instead of ratifying these names before the election, a list of all the selected members (with their posts) shall be submitted to a nominee of the Students' Senate, in a sealed envelope
- Envelope shall be opened in following situations
 - After the electoral process is completed, in the presence of the Senate and the process of ratification is completed
 - In case of any mala fide, after a proper investigation of the case, the envelope can be opened by a committee
 - Proposed structure of the committee: Senate nominee (list bearer), EC nominee, Chairperson, Students' Senate (or any other Senate nominee), one nominee each of the claimant and defendant
- This process of ratification shall be valid for each and every elections which are responsibility of the Election Council
