General Championship: 2013-14



The Intra-IIT Competitions to be covered under the General Championship are as follows:

- Galaxy
- Spectrum
- Inferno
- Takneek
- Energy Competition
- Academics

All students would be divided into 4 pools, based on their hall of residence for the purpose of this championship. The Pool Structure finalized for this year's championship is as follows:

Hall 1 and Hall 9 is given the status of a parent hall, implying that Students' in Hall 1 and Hall 9, shall participate from the hostel, which they had been allotted in their first year at IIT Kanpur. This rule is applicable only for the students of Hall-1 and non-fresher students of hall 9.

Each one of these competitions shall be handled by one of the general secretaries (listed below).

- Galaxy: General Secretary, Cultural Council
- Spectrum: General Secretary, Films & Media Council
- Inferno: General Secretary, Games & Sports Council
- Takneek: General Secretary, Science & Technology Council
- Academics: A committee formed by the SS with President, Students' Gymkhana as the chair
- Energy Competition: President, Students' Gymkhana

The General Secretary shall make available on a public forum a detailed report, containing the description and point structure and announce the same through mail to all Students. Any deviation from the announced details is strongly discouraged and would have to be approved by the General Secretary.

The percentage distribution for the overall championship is as follows:

Academics : 16%
Inferno : 18%
Takneek : 18%
Spectrum : 18%
Galaxy : 18%
Green Opus : 12%

The First, Second, Third & Fourth positions in all events shall attract points as per the following ratio: 1, 0.6, 0.3, and 0.1.

The dates for the Gymkhana competitions (according to the Calendar) are as follows

Inferno: 15th August – 18th August
Takneek: 29th August – 1st September
Spectrum: 30th January- 2nd February

• Galaxy: 2nd April – 6th April

The dates and other relevant details for Energy Competition shall be presented to the Senate in the next meeting. Prior to the event, the General Secretary will be supposed to present a pre-conduction report to the SS.

A Grievance Redressal Committee shall be setup for each competition following the modalities which are already in place. Any grievances not solved by the organizing team shall go to the GRC.

After the competition, the concerned General Secretary/Organizing Body shall present a post-conduction report and the results in the Senate, which shall be put up for ratification.
