



Major Changes in Rules and Regulations

- 1. The candidates are allowed to make digital posters for the purpose of canvassing.
- 2. Procedure to raise grievance for pre-election conduct:

To ensure that the Elections are free and fair in the true sense, it is important that the candidates for the elections adhere to the spirit of the elections even before the imposition of the code of conduct. Hence after nominations are filed, we intend to send out a mail to the general student body to raise grievances regarding violation of this spirt and the election council would take action accordingly.

3. Nominations for Girls Representative would be called in case no girl student files nomination any post in the senate.

Other Initiatives

- 1. A separate polling booth would be set-up in the academic area to increase PG participation in the elections.
- 2. <u>Meet the Executives</u>: We are organizing a new event to increase voter participation especially in post-graduate halls.

We will be holding debates between the contesting candidates on important campus issues. The event would have the following structure-

a. The event would be held in two phases:

On 9th January 2015, the Presidential Debates would be held in the Hall IV quad (tentatively). These debates would be held in collaboration with Vox. The panel for the debate would consist of journalists and election council members.

On 10th January 2015, the debates for other executives would be held in the Hall IX quand (tentatively). This event is being held independently by the Election Council and the panel would consist of senior members of the students 'gymkhana and EC members

General Instructions

- 1. Nomination forms would be available at Election Council site students.iitk.ac.in/ss/elections/
- 2. Election fees and Security Deposit for the post of Senators are Rs. 100/- and Rs. 200/- respectively. The same for Executives is Rs.500/- and Rs.1000/-

- 3. All candidates for the senator post will have to be proposed by one registered student and seconded by two registered students on the nomination form by members of their respective electorate. For the executives the two proposers and 5 seconders are required.
- 4. Candidates must bring official grade sheet issued by DOAA office, photocopies of their own I-card and I-card of the students who have proposed and seconded him/her along with their original I-cards for verification, duly signed.

Candidates must also bring the persons who have proposed and seconded him/her for verification at the time of filing nominations.
