Dear all,

We have prepared a map of signal strength data, for all the hostels. This has been carried over the past few days, during night hours (post 11:00 pm) when the observed signal strength is lower as compared to rest of the day. Due to the paucity of time, we could only carry it out for Airtel and Tata Docomo networks considering their large user base in IIT Kanpur and considering the availability of students to aid us in this initiative.

We could not carry out an extensive analysis for the day-time, though as per what we could collate, we didn't find the strength to rise more than -40dBm anytime of the day. For the analysis done for the night time, as we can see the values are too low in some hostels (though, you may consider a variation of ± 4 dBm while taking the readings in most cases).
