2. Election fees and Security Deposit for the post of Senators are Rs. 100/- and Rs. 200/- respectively.
3. All candidates for the senator post will have to be proposed by one registered student and seconded by two registered students on the nomination form by members of their respective electorate
4. Candidates must bring no outstanding backlogs certificate and official grade sheet issued by DOAA office, photocopies of their own I-card and I-card of the students who have proposed and seconded him/her along with their original I-cards for verification, duly signed.

Candidates must also bring the persons who have proposed and seconded him/her for verification at the time of filing nominations
