To consider the following proposal on discontinuing the current practice of debarring the students from peripheral benefits/activities for periods extending the stipulated duration

This has been noticed, in practice, that the students punished under disciplinary actions are deprived of the debarred benefits in the periods extending the stipulated period of corrective action e.g. Disciplinary Probation period. This includes Scholarship provisions, SPO Placements and others. There are also cases of these provisions withdrawn for periods beyond the Warning Period, which is very counter intuitive. The minutes of the 487th meeting of the Academic Senate, dated 23 & 24th May, 2016 mentions a recommendation "Students who have been awarded punishment or disciplinary action by the Senate/SSAC of any level including level 0 will not be eligible to receive any award/scholarship". The same is being followed by the SSPC presently. The Students' Senate proposes that unless a specific period for such peripheral provisions is mentioned at the time of ruling. by the recommending body, primarily the SSAC, the deprivation shall last only the period of Disciplinary Probation or the Warning Period. The Students' Senate shall consider to resist the mentioned, to provide a meaningful impact to these uncalled for actions.
