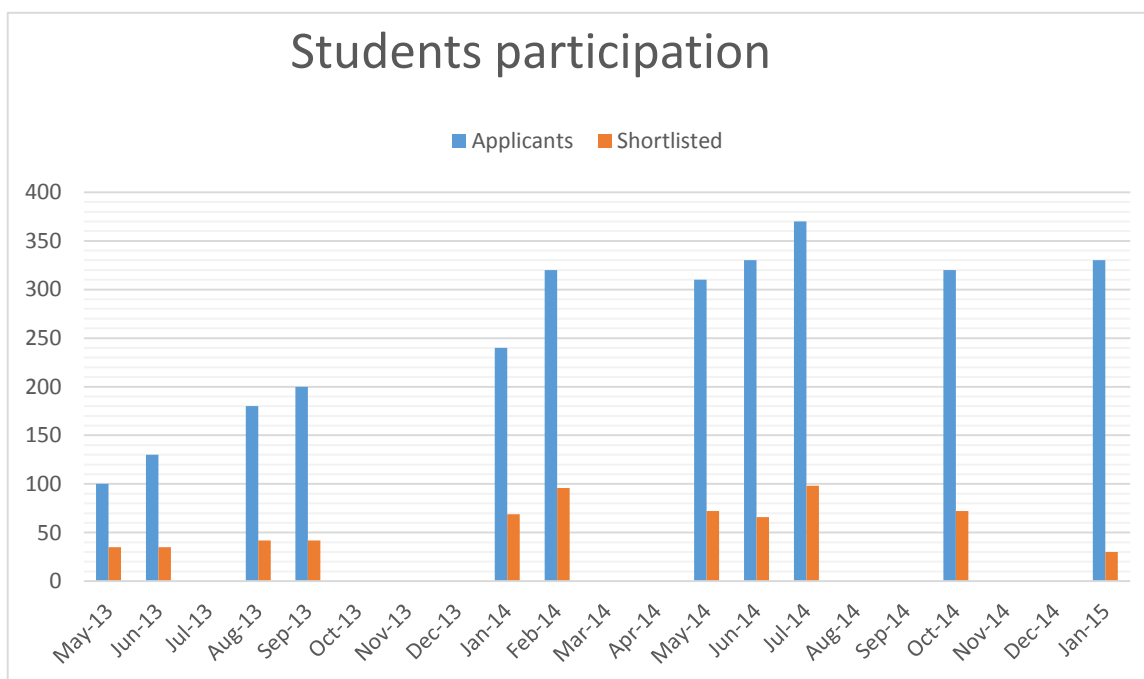
CONVERSION OF 'SHOOTING HOBBY GROUP' IN TO A 'CLUB'



ACTIVITIES:



- Over 700+ students have experienced the grandiosity of this elite sport.



INITIATIVES:

Institute Level Workshop: To involve Professors along with students

- More than seven Professors became part of the workshop hence also enhances student- professor interaction.



Regular Training for District/State Championship:

- Sixteen students represented IIT Kanpur in Kanpur District and 37th U.P. State Championship. The three month training was funded by DORA/DOSA.



ACHEIVEMENTS:

- **Kanpur District Championship:** IIT Kanpur secured 1st rank in district championship bagging highest no. of golds and silvers.



- **37TH U.P. State Championship :** IIT Kanpur bagged three 'Silver Medal' in women category. Apart from this three of our students were selected for Pre-nationals.



- **Selected for Nationals:** Prachi Mishra, a student of 3rd year got selected for Shooting Nationals.

RECCOMENDATION:

Conversion of 'Shooting Hobby Group' in to a 'Club':

Every workshop requires around 10,000Rs which is paid by the students in the form of workshop fees of 175 Rs per slot per student

Rs 175 for just a practice slot of 0.5 hour is too **costly** which results in to lack of interest of students in pursuing out this sport. Due to the reason less than 10% students have ever attended three or more than three workshops. 50% subsidy would require 5,000 Rs per workshop and according to the timeline for the upcoming year shooting hobby group needs around **50,000 Rs subsidized fund** for regular workshops and regular based practice of some good performing students to enhance the growing culture of this sport in the campus as well as to represent our institute in various **district, state and national level championships**.

Such a huge subsidize amount can't be met via **Student seed funds (SSF's)**. Hence, It is strongly recommended to convert shooting hobby group in to the **Shooting club** under **Games & Sports Council** for proper & regular conduction of it's activities. It will help in establishing the strong **culture of shooting** sport in the campus & will give our students a taste of the sport.

A well established club and the culture of this sport is highly required also to maintain and regulate the upcoming **Institute Shooting Range**.
