Currently, the Under-Graduate projects are offered on an ad-hoc basis, subject to the availability of a dummy professor and approval from the DUGC convener. A lot of times the inter-disciplinary UGPs are not allowed in the departments.

Proposal:

It is recommended that the current UGPs be divided into two categories:

- Departmental UGPs
- Open UGPs

The Open UGPs can be given as an alternative to the OE slots in the course templates. These UGPs will require prior approval from the instructor and from the DUGC conveners of both the departments. Further, the final grading should be approved by the DUGC convener of the parent department.
