Introduction

UDGHOSH, Annual Sports Festival of IIT Kanpur was organized during 26th -29th September 2013. UDGHOSH is one of the largest sports festivals in the country with participation from about **54 colleges** (unprecedented growth in a very short span of time. With a participation of around **1500 students**, in **including the IITs**, **NITs and other major institutes**) around the country offering an unparalleled competitive environment. Udghosh has emerged as a brand in itself and has seen addition to the **6000 strong student community**, the recent past has deservedly witnessed the apotheosis of Udghosh.

UDGHOSH offers a platform for students from all over India to showcase their talent and compete with the best upcoming sport persons in the country in a highly charged and competitive ambience with highly equipped sports facilities. The festival comprises of a plethora of events from Motivational Talks, Gymnastic Shows and Sport Quizzes to various sports events like Athletics, Cricket, Football, Hockey, Volleyball, Basketball, Badminton, Tennis, Table Tennis, Weightlifting, Kho-Kho and Cycling Events.

Marketing and Media Research

This year Udghosh has witnessed a huge improvement in marketing in all dimensions. Getting sponsorship from sports companies is very difficult but even though UDGHOSH'13 raised an amount of around ₹6.8 lakhs in comparison to ₹4.16 lakhs in UDGHOSH'12.

UDGHOSH'13 got **3 advertisements and coverage** in **The Pioneer** and other news daily. UDGHOSH also partnered with **Cricket Today**, one of the top sports magazine in India.

Mega banners and posters were widely used this year to spread awareness regarding the happenings in the festival.

For the 1st time Udghosh introduced its **app** turning out to be a huge success resulting in less number of queries on the hospitality desk.

Results

IIT Kanpur performed brilliantly and secured 1st position in Athletics (Men), Athletics (Women), Badminton (Men), Squash, Table Tennis (Men) and Weightlifting.

IITK finished runner ups in Chess, Carrom and Volleyball (Men). Complete results have been circulated among all.

Closing Ceremony & Prize Distribution ceremony

Udghosh'13 was ended with the closing ceremony on 29th September, 2013. Ms. Ashwini Ponnappa (Indian Ace Shuttler) was the Chief Guest of honour. The crowd appreciated the personalities very well and these personalities were invited to promote the less known sports and appreciate the talent of physically challenged people and moving out of trend of inviting cricket personalities.

A friendly match was organized between the participants and Ms. Ashwini Ponnapa which boosted the morale of all the sportsperson.

There was also Motivational and Interactive Talk with Ms. Ashwini Ponnappa, and vote of thanks was also given by the Festival Coordinator to the students.

Prizes, medals and trophies worth ₹1.4 lakhs were distributed to the Winners in all the Sporting events.



Professional Shows

- 1. Opening Night: A torch run around the campus followed by performance of 'Avijit & Tinku Acrobats Group' in OAT, New SAC was organized on 26th September, 2013.
- 2. Step Up: Live up the Floor
 Discotheque was organized on the 2nd night at Hall 1 Parking Lot near PE grounds
- 3. **Fiesta**: On 3rd night, a formal dinner was organized for all the participants of Udghosh'13 including the faculties and participants of IIT Kanpur.
- 4. Closing Night: A felicitation ceremony preceded by Director's Address was organized to praise the efforts of all the participants which will be followed by an Informal session with our Sports Celebrity 'Ms. Ashwini Ponnappa'.
- 5. Movie screening & Live matches of 'Champions League T-20' and 'Barclays Premier League' was organized in OAT, New SAC during all the 4 days of the festival.

Challenges

- 1. Intra campus tempo services were provided to outstation participants because people especially at Hall 10, 9 etc. kept complaining of distance problem to the field and common areas.
- 2. Rain Scenario: Udghosh'13 witnessed rains on the last day of the festival and also heavy rains 1 week before the festival raised huge concerns regarding ground maintenance. Hence like this year flexes, sponges, sand trolleys (2 trolleys were arranged pre festival), water pumps etc. were arranged in stock. All the outdoor matches were shifted to indoor grounds.
- 3. Unavailability of New SAC area for setting up the food stalls. Due to this we had to shift the stalls and informal stage to the New SAC extension which was less crowd attractive.
- 4. Organizing a Festival just after the mid-semester exams created several problems.





Recommendations

- 1. Udghosh'13 Team strongly recommends that a festival **should preferably not** be organized **immediately after mid-semester examinations**.
- 2. Udghosh team suggests that festival should be organized in **last week of September or latter** so as to avoid rains and ensure smooth conduction of events.
- 3. It is suggested by the current team that **UDGHOSH Core team interviews** should get over by **early November every year**.
- 4. In UDGHOSH there is need for 2 Head Marketing otherwise it creates additional pressure on Festival Coordinator and other core team members.
- 5. There is also requirement for 2 Head Show Management as the number of sporting events has increased. Marathon, Shows etc. also demand too much resources and time.
- 6. Since the number of events are too many in UDGHOSH, under Head Events there should be one Event Executives (preferably 3rd year) for each event who shall take care of all the events. These posts would be different from the Event Coordinators.
- 7. Equipment tender should be released at least 30 days before festival because procurement of all the equipment takes very long time.
- 8. Special focus should be there on getting sponsorship from sports equipment making companies like **Yonex**, **Wilson etc.** in whose absence we have to pay a big amount. Some of these companies are interested and would be sponsoring in coming years.
- 9. Several Informal activities and shows which were introduced this year should be continued even next time as this leads to huge participation from campus junta.
- 10. **Fiesta, the Gala night** which was introduced this year helps create a new ambience for the festival. Also it allows participants to relax and entertain themselves during the festival. Hence, this must be carried forward which will prove to be uniqueness for Udghosh. Also a separate tender processing should be done for the same.
- 11. Messing for the referees should be arranged in Hall Messes rather than opting for Central Mess.
- 12. Mascot should be designed for the festival which should represent the festival nationwide. This will prove to be prominent point in marketing and design for the festival.
