
AAVEG - National Sports Day



RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. We believe that Udghosh should be a three-and-a-half-day fest to improve the competition level of the sports events and for the smooth conduction of all the fixtures. The same can be taken forward to DoSA and DoAA as it is easily possible to accommodate 2 Gymkhana holidays in a semester by including an extra working Saturday and this small issue of a holiday must not lead to compromising the Gymkhana festivals.
- 2. There was an incident of misconduct from the Amity Lucknow contingent on the last day of the festival. Appropriate measures can be taken to avoid such incidents in the future.
- 3. There must be a clear idea and communication to the festival teams from the involved administrative authorities of where the festivals lie in relation to the financial liabilities and rules. All the festivals face issues every year where they are always in a dilemma on the matters relating to whether to follow GFR or Non-GFR rules.
