WORK DONE/DISCUSSIONS HELD

- Hall allocation policy 2012-13
- Pool allocation for general championship
- Proposal for prevention of water logging in front of hall 5 during monsoon and construction of footpath

- A letter was forwarded to IWD. The proposal has been accepted and tentative construction of footpaths will begin next year (before monsoon).
- As requested by the HECs, an E-Store near Hall 7 will soon be functional.

- Hall 5: A letter for Fruit shop proposal was sent to the chairman, CEMMC. Request was accepted and it's being followed.
- Hall 8: A request for the Barber shop was made and was not accepted by the authority. Sufficient explanation was provided by the authority.
- Hall 9: A request for Barber shop and a common room was made. A letter has been sent to IWD. It's being followed
- A letter has been forwarded to all Hall Wardens and concerned faculty members through DOSA and the President, Students' Gymkhana. The reply is awaited.
- The proposal is being deliberated upon in the Group of Deans. We haven't received any reply till now. It's need to be followed.

- Discussion regarding bad quality of water in Hall 7.

A Meeting was held with superintendent engineer, IWD. A water quality check was ordered by the IWD superintendent, Mr. Rajiv Garg. A confirmation is awaited from both the authority and the Hall-7 HEC. A letter requesting the same has already been sent to IWD.

- Minimum Wage proposal

It was felt by the HECs that a meeting of all the canteen vendors was not required. All the HECs have been requested to ensure that minimum wage rule is followed by the canteen vendors in respective halls.
- Hall requirement List

The requirement lists of furniture and other items have been collected from all the Halls and the same has been forwarded.
- Recommendations from the previous COSHA convener

Both the recommendations were considered and the required actions have been taken.

 - Canteen dues should be separated from the Mess dues.
- Discussion and ratification of the Dates for Hall Festivals to be conducted in the second semester of this year.
