
The proposal aims to establish a student lounge in the academic area, near Library.



Objective

- Proper utilization of time in between the lectures.
- On lines of CCD, focus on improving faculty-student interaction.
- Hang-out place where people can :
 - Study
 - Conduct Discussions
 - Introspect
 - Ideate
 - Sit together
- Providing an ambient place for the student community in the academic area.
- Making academic area livelier.
- Providing a comfortable seating area. People can switch to lounge from library.

Proposed Location



This serves as the ideal location because:

1. The lounge, near the CCD will serve as an extension to library as well as to an area to sit in the mean time and relax.
2. Architecture can be done in a manner to not to remove trees because open area is also needed.
3. Being located alongside the library serves it being an alternative place to study.

Picturesque & Facilities

Open Area

- An open area forming the entrance.
- Benches to be put up. (can be permanent structures as well made of stone)
- Green area adding to aesthetic value of the area

Ground Floor

- 10 Discussion cabins with seating capacity of around 20 students.
- Projector facility in all rooms.
- Coffee vending machines to be installed (in future.)
- Theme based rooms to create pleasant ambience.
- Washrooms

First Floor

- Enclosed by glass walls, with single inside-outside view. Shades to be put along.
- A large open space covered with thick carpet flooring.
- Bean bags, chairs, sofas and tables placed.
- Multiple socket points for students to work on their laptops.
- White-Boards to be put-up on walls.

Alongside:

1. **Hi-speed Wi-Fi** to be ensured.
2. Proper lighting during all times of the day
3. Sound-Proof walls, to avoid external disturbances.

Modus-Operandi

- No requirement to book rooms. Anyone can drop in and use the discussion rooms by making an entry in the register.
- Snacks and coffee won't be allowed on the first floor.
- To be open **24 hours**
 - No proper place to meet and discuss, especially at odd times of the day, and on weekends.
 - Currently computer science lounge is the only area where both male and female students can meet to discuss projects, academic related work, etc
- 4 people (in different shifts) to be appointed for overall maintenance of the lounge and care-taking.
