Cloud bursts in Uttarakhand, 375% more than benchmark rainfall.

Jun 16

Director of the Meteorological Centre Anand Sharma said: “We have declared monsoons in Uttarakhand today [Saturday, 15th Jun,2013] and have warned the Uttarakhand Disaster Management and Mitigation Centre of 72 hours of continuous downpour in the State.” Pilgrims stranded due to landslides. Thousands of Char Dham pilgrims were stranded on Gangotri and Yamunotri routes, as incessant overnight showers across Uttarakhand caused landslips in Uttarkashi district and swollen rivers.

A house caved in in the Prem Nagar area, a senior police official said, adding that a 30-year-old man, his 26-year-old wife and 10-year-old child died on the way to hospital after they sustained grievous injuries. Eight persons were killed yesterday in three separate incidents of house collapse in Dehradun and landslips in Rudraprayag districts.
