### 2. Blog Writing

The article will be judged on the basis of:

Content -	20%
Literary Skills -	20%
Coherence -	20%
Story Line-	15%
Research -	15%
Wit/Humor -	10%

Negative marks for grammatical errors, spelling mistakes or any derogatory remarks.

Plagiarism in any form will not be accepted and lead to immediate disqualification.

**Note:** The decision of judges will be final and no further debate will be allowed. **Note:** The weightage of first and second part is 50% each.
