Pool Event (Open to all)

Points: 30

Guidelines-

1. From each pool only one team can participate in this event. Each team can have AT MOST 4 members. Registration will be done on the spot.

2. The event will consist of two stages:-

i) One team member amongst the four will have to sit in the glider. S/he will be provided a map of IITK. The same member has to identify the location of object which will be hidden anywhere in IITK campus with the help of a binoculars and tell the other members through a communication medium (walkie-talkie) about the location of the objects.

ii) Rest of the members will have to go to the respective locations as directed by the person in glider and collect the objects. Nearby each object, there will be a secretary of our club. The members have to report to the secretary with the object. Time taken for collecting objects and reporting will be noted down.

Complete event is time bound.

Time distribution-

- 1. Time provided for flying in the glider 10 min.
- 2. Max time allowed for collecting objects and reporting to secretaries 35 min.

Point distribution -

- i) For identifying the location correctly 30% weightage
- ii) For collecting the objects and reporting to secretaries 70% weightage

Tie breaker rules-

- i) In case of two teams scoring equals points, decision will be made on the basis of time i.e. the team who takes minimum time for the completion of event will be the winner.
- ii) In case the time taken is same, decision will be in the favor of the team which first identifies the object and its location.
