

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY COUNCIL **TAKNEEK '18** ON THE SHOULDERS OF GIANTS



Heavens Above

Team Event Points: 30

Any number of teams of at most 3 members can register for the event. However, all the members must be Y18 (UG and/or PG) from the same pool. Registration should be done in advance. For every round, the teams will be given a particular time slot and teams will have to be present during that time at the venue. Any delay of more than 5 minutes will lead to the disqualification, unless any of the astronomy club coordinators is informed at least 30 minutes before their respective slot.

Event structure:

The event will be held in 3 separate rounds:

A. The first round will test the participating teams' basic understanding of astronomy, the sky and other introductory concepts in related topics. The participants will be shown a simulated sky (northern and southern hemisphere) in the planetarium at Astronomy Club. They will have to identify celestial objects. (Simulation Software: Stellarium)

B. The second round will require a bit more of technical approach to observational astronomy, and may involve some basic numerical analysis of observed data. Participants will have to solve a set of astrophysical questions.

C. The third round will require more direct knowledge of objects in the sky, and may also comprise of a component of instrument usage (telescope). This will be a rapid fire round of 2 minutes duration.

At the end of the first round, 30% of the number of teams that participated for the first round, or 10 teams, whichever is lesser, will qualify for the 2nd round. At most 5 teams will qualify for the 3rd round. The final ranking will be decided on the basis of the score achieved by each of these 5 teams in all three rounds combined, with the weightages of rounds 1, 2 and 3 in the ratio of: **Twice the Light Year : Parsec : Distance to the second nearest star** respectively. (All data is as taken from en.wikipedia.org).

Note: In case of tie between the teams after all the three rounds, we will have a questionnaire round. In case of any dispute, decision of Astronomy club shall be final and irrevocable.
