

Committee on Gymkhana Blues

Report

Discussion

This Committee discussed the agenda tabled by Mr. Anurag Sahay in the 1st special meeting of the Students' Senate (2016-17). We focused on the ways to implement the proposed changes in the structure of the award as the proposal had already been accepted in principle by the Senate.

Implementation:

Eligibility Criterion for recipients: The committee that shall be appointed by the Senate shall follow the current specifications in Appendix G along with the following:

The committee shall first ascertain the tenure of the individual in which he/she contributed the most to the Gymkhana. If the time between consideration and said major tenure is at least 2 years and at most 3 years then all the contributions made by the individual to the Gymkhana from the time of his entering the institute to the time of consideration shall be examined by the committee.

Accountability of the Committee: To ensure that there is no bias in the functioning and decision of the committee, it will have to collect paper trail/document proof about a claim made about an individual being considered or have it counter verified at least once.

Size and composition of the Committee: The Committee was of the opinion that placing 5 General Body members in the committee (as proposed) would make the committee too unwieldy and thus recommends that the number be cut down to 3.

The committee shall be as follows:

1. President, Students' Gymkhana (Convener)
2. Chairperson, Students' Senate
3. One UG Senator, nominated by the Students' Senate
4. One PG Senator, nominated by the Students' Senate
5. 3 General Body Members, nominated by the Students' Senate

All the members of this committee shall be preferably of the Graduating batch.
