It is often pointed out that Senators do not follow up their manifestos presented during elections. We want to propose a follow-up procedure for manifestos. The Idea behind this Proposal is to improve upon the manifestos and ensure their proper implementation. If the senate agrees to the following idea, we can have this implemented before these elections.

Proposal: Steering committee/any other committee suggested by senate could draft a document with all the proposals from manifestos in it. The committee may merge/select distinct proposals but cannot remove any proposal however vague it may seem. Then the document will be tabled in the senate. If any senator feels that his agenda is not presented, he may propose it later. Then, as it should be, senators will follow up their proposals.

Note: Senators here refer to all members of Students' senate.
