

To consider a restructuring of the Standing Committees of the Student Senate

1) To consider the dissolution of Steering Committee

The mandate of the Steering Committee is to prepare agenda documents and publish the minutes of the meeting. It shall also assist the Chairperson in organising meetings of the Senate. Its current composition has 2 UG Senators and 2 PG Senators. However, a Senator, as a representative cannot be expected to carry this out. As a result of which, the steering committee has not been effective in its functioning over the last few years.

We would like to propose that the steering committee be dissolved. Since the constitution allows the Chairperson, Students' Senate to nominate General Body Member as Secretary(s) under the office of Students' Senate, the work of the Steering Committee shall be discharged to the Secretary(s), by the Senate, on the recommendation of the Chairperson.

2) To consider a change in the size of Standing Committees

The Students' Senate (2013-14) in its 6th Special Meeting, decided to expand the size of the standing committees of the Senate based on the increase in the size of the Senate in the last few years. However, since the size of the incoming Senate has once again reduced, we would like to make the following proposal-

- The number of non ex-officio members of the Rules and Procedure Committee and the Steering Committee (in case it is not dissolved) be reduced from 4 to 3.
- The number of non ex-officio members of the Nominations Committee shall be reduced from 2 to 1.
- The number of non ex-officio members of the Finance Committee shall be reduced from 3 to 2.

3) To consider a change in the composition of COFA

As of now, the In-charge, COFA is nominated by the Nominations Committee and is the ex-officio Convener of COFA, who represents COFA in the Senate and Senate in the COFA. We would like to propose the following-

- The post of In-charge, COFA shall be removed and its duties shall be handed over to the General Secretary of the corresponding council, who is also the ex-officio Chairperson of the respective COFA.
- In case of a joint meeting of the COFA, it shall be called and presided over the President, Students' Gymkhana
