

Agenda for revision in salary of Taekwondo Coach

Balram Yadav is coach of Taekwondo club from 1985 and working sincerely till now. He is a **4th Dan** black belt which is rare to find in India. He participated in **National Poomsae championship** and achieved **2 Bronze** and **1 Silver** medal in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

He is getting **₹250 per day basis wage** from student gymkhana **since 2007** and has not been revised yet which is quite unfair because

1. His increment from ₹250 to ₹350 was approved in 2013 but which was implemented by the administration.
2. He works from Monday to Saturday which results in 25 to 26 working days of a month, but he gets salary for 20 days only.
3. We increased our registration fees by putting more burdens on students from ₹100 winter to ₹200 summer ₹350 semester to ₹400 respectively from 2013 to increase student gymkhana's fund.
4. There is also an increment in number of students registered from previous years.
5. To increase his professional qualification he give Dan promotion test whose onetime cost falls around ₹20000 per test.

We propose for an increment in salary from ₹250 to ₹500 expecting next salary revision may take some years.
