Subject: Inconsistencies in Number of Seats being filled and Number of Senate Approved Seats for M-Tech and M-Des programs.

Dear Sir,

This is to bring to your notice with reference to the 6th meeting/2012-13 of the Senate held on 4th February 2013, that this year, certain departments, in a single go, have offered seats to more applicants than those that had been approved by the Senate for the M-Tech and M-Des programs. As a result, even after attrition, some departments have received payment of fees from number of applicants exceeding the maximum number of seats in that department.

Because of this situation, we will be facing certain grave problems.

1. Space Crunch in Halls.
2. Possible degradation of education standards in the respected programs due to increase in class sizes, which may eventually lead to increased number of terminations.

The Students' Senate after considering this matter opined that this is in essence an overruling of the decision of the Senate that must have been made after due deliberation.

Therefore, the Students' Senate decided that this matter must be brought to the notice of Senate so that the necessary action, as deemed appropriate by the Senate, may be taken to avoid such violation of Senate rulings in the future.
