

## **AGENDA FOR MEETING**

### **On Sports' Facility:-**

The timing for sports' facility (upper limit being 09:00pm) at both old SAC and new SAC is not very conducive for the PG students owing to their lab schedule. Hence, I have received several requests for increasing the time from 9pm till 11 pm from Monday till Saturday so that those who come from lab late for dinner could avail sports facility post dinner time without their work being affected.

On question of handling of logistical issues which would arise while turning such a proposal into reality, I would suggest rescheduling of the existing time and allotting slots to the workers so that they are not burdened with additional work hours. During weekdays, owing to the academic time table, it has been observed that the students wouldn't avail sports facility during daytime between 11-2:30 pm. Hence, during this time, SAC could be closed and it could be kept open till 11pm at night when more students (including PG population) could avail the facilities meant for them.

With regards to the workers at SAC, it seems viable to divide the 4 existing staff members into team of 2 and they could be allotted slots so as to ensure none of them are overburdened with work with the change in time. That would ensure effective and efficient utilisation of human resources and allow the students for greater participation in sports physical activities and ensure their fitness.

Also, I would like to bring to the attention of the senators the dismal condition of the electrical fittings at some of the indoor courts (for example, badminton courts) which are defective and needs to be repaired/replaced at the earliest.

### **On question of decreasing electricity bill**

It has been brought under my attention that the mess exhaust fans are used by the mess workers when they are not cooking and this is a major reason contributing to increase in electricity bills due to higher consumption of electrical units. I would suggest surprise visit by the members of mess committee to ensure this is not encouraged and it put on check. If the mess workers are found

engaging in such activities, the mess contractor could be levied fine and let him/her decide whom to punish and how to put this on check. I feel this action would have positive impact on our electricity bills and bring it down by a few notches.
