Remarks:

- GH 2 remained the hostel with the highest amount of per capita electricity consumption, for the fourth year running.
- The amount of food wasted witnessed a significant reduction as the month progressed. The halls which have installed the bins in their messes as a regular feature were at a clear advantage since the wastage was very low.
- Hall 10 significantly reduced its overall consumption by more than 33%.
- Adequate publicity for Phase I could not be done due to paucity of funds. The budget for Green Opus should be increased slightly, considering the scale of the event.
- The miscellaneous events served their purpose, since they provided an advantage to the pools which gave utmost attention to awareness
