

## Pre-conduction Report

### DUGC/DPGC student nominee elections

#### Election Schedule

1. The elections shall be conducted as per the following schedule

Dates	
DPGC Elections	29 <sup>th</sup> , 30 <sup>th</sup> and 31 <sup>st</sup> August
DUGC Elections	29 <sup>th</sup> , 30 <sup>th</sup> and 31 <sup>st</sup> August

#### Election Procedure

Nominations	20 minutes
SOP Box	40 minutes
Casting of Votes	30 minutes

1. Polling booths shall be setup in the LHC according to the aforementioned schedule.
2. Nominations shall be accepted on the spot, contingent to the candidate fulfilling the eligibility requirements as ordained by the Gymkhana Constitution.
3. Nominations shall be followed by a Statement of Purpose by each candidate; which in turn shall be followed by casting of votes.
4. In case of a low voter turnout, a department can suggest the names of their DUGC/DPGC representatives backed by a simple majority.

#### Electorate

1. The electoral roll for each department shall consist of all registered students of the department.
2. Double major students shall be allowed to cast a vote for each of their majors.
3. Number of Posts for DPGC – 14 Nominations.
4. Number of Posts for DUGC – 22 Nominations.

### SOP Box

1. The SOP Box shall last 40 minutes with the last 10 minutes reserved for questions by the audience.
2. All questions shall require the permission of the chair.
3. The SOP Box shall be chaired by a previous DUGC/DPGC convener along with a senator of preferably the same department.

### Promotions

1. A website shall be created containing the information about the functioning of DUGC and DPGC.
2. Posters and info-grams shall be put up in all halls.
3. The DUGC chair of each department shall be asked to forward the circular about elections.

### Budget

1. The budget shall be presented in the post-conduction report.
