1. Overview

The General Elections for the Student's Gymkhana and Senate were held from 05th January to 23rd January 2024.

The nomination process went quite smoothly, and all submitted manifestos were ratified by the concerned executives. The EC implemented a portal for campaigner registration to prevent double registration and to ensure the consent of the GBM. This portal can be used for further processes as well after modifications.

Campaigning was done completely offline, with no exceptions given save for poster sharing. There were no major issues with campaigning, and minor issues were resolved in consultation with the candidates.

The Executive Dialogue And Debate Sessions received good attendeeship and served as an excellent platform for the candidates to engage in constructive debate. The Soap Box sessions were well participated in by the GBM and served as a good forum for the GBMs to engage with their candidates. Due to unfortunate circumstances, we couldn't conduct the Soap Box for the posts of General Secretary, Science and Technology Council and President, Students' Gymkhana.

Polling was conducted, and the process went quite smoothly, with no concerns raised. Envelope Voting was done for those who couldn't be present physically on campus.

Counting of votes was done in the presence of GRC members and nominees of candidates of posts for which polling was done.

4. Complaints to GRC

There were 2 complaints filed to the Grievance Redressal Committee:

1. The first complaint was filed against a sitting executive for wrongly ratifying a candidate’s manifesto. The GRC discussed the case and recommended that the ratifying executive be more careful with ratifications but did not recommend any changes to the manifesto.
2. The second complaint was filed by a candidate against the Election Commission's decision to cancel their nomination. The GRC took the candidate's testimony and the Election Commission's testimony, after which they discussed the validity of the proofs submitted. The GRC upheld the decision of the Election Commission to

cancel the candidate's nomination along with the addendum that the other candidate mentioned in the proof should also have their nomination cancelled.

5. Complaints to AGRC

No complaints were filed to the Appellate Grievance Redressal Committee.

6. Polling

1. Polling was held on 21st January 2024 from 10:00 hrs to 18:00 hrs.
2. The polling was held in offline mode, but people who were not present on campus were given the option to do envelope voting. Those who were present on campus on polling day needed to come to the Polling Booths to cast their votes. The offline polling process was under the due vigilance of the Election Commission and SiS guards.

10. Recommendations:
