Pool Structure

- **Inferno '23 (Mens Pools)**

Responsibilities of Pool/Hall Captains

- Pool/Hall Captains are responsible for ensuring participation from each Pool/Hall in all events.
- Only the Pool Captain may file complaints, if any, to the Inferno Core Team, during the event. Pool Captains can request a meeting from the General Secretary, Games and Sports between various Pool Captains and the Inferno Core Team if he/she feels there has been any controversy/ complaint during the competition. The calling of the meeting is totally at the discretion of the General Secretary, Games and Sports. The following members allowed in the meeting:
 - o General Secretary, Games & Sports
 - o Overall Coordinators, Inferno '23 (including ISec(s))
 - o Pool Captains of each pool (Nominees, if appointed, must belong to the same pool)
 - o SGRC Members (Nominees are not allowed)
- All the pool captains are required to be present on campus during Inferno dates and are bound to attend all the meetings. They can send a nominee to the meetings, only if they are out of campus and they have to notify the General Secretary, Games and Sports through the mail prior to the meeting. In any case, the Pool Captain/Nominee of the Pool Captain shall be held accountable.

Event Rulebook

General Rules:

- Only registered players (including extras) will be permitted to play the matches. Violations can lead to disqualification/penalty. All the registered players must carry their ID cards and are expected to present them for verification whenever asked.
- In the case of sports with round robin format (for the case of Inferno, with four teams in the league stage) in league stages, the top 3 teams will qualify for the next stage, in which the 1st standing team will directly qualify for the finals, and the 2nd and the 3rd standing team will play the qualifiers in which the winning team will qualify for the finals while the losing team will be placed third.
- In any case of updates in rule/format for any game, it will be informed to the Team/Pool Captain/Hall Captain by the Organizing Team Inferno '23 before the match.
- In case of any discrepancy, the decision of the Core Team, Inferno '23 shall be final. No individual/team/representative holds the right to challenge/disrespect any decision made by the referees/umpires on the ground. Any instance of violation can attract penalties/disqualification of the pool/team/individual.
- In case of any negative cheering, or use of abusive language against another pool or individual on or around the event site, the individual/ group/ team/ pool can be penalized/ disqualified/ reported to SSAC on the discretion of the Core Team, Inferno '23.
- In the event of any further disagreement, the Core Team of Inferno'23 has the authority to make the ultimate decision.

- All teams are expected to report 15 minutes prior to the scheduled time of their match. A walkover can be given to the opposite team in case of a delay of more than 15 minutes or multiple instances of late arrivals on the discretion of the Core Team, Inferno '23.
- Any violation by a player/individual will be considered as a violation of their respective pool.
- Before the tournament, each team would have to submit its seeding to the referee, and before every match, they would have to tell the non-playing players to the referee.
- The players must ensure that they wear proper attire according to their sports.
- A more detailed rulebook with a proper code of conduct and detailed fixtures will be shared in a meeting with the Pool Captains.

Disruption/Postponement

Any event abandoned or disrupted due to unavoidable reasons shall be postponed or continued as the case may be and per the rules specified in the current regulations of the respective sports. In a case where the sports rules cannot be implemented, the decision will be left to the General Secretary, Games and Sports, whose decision shall be final.

Conduct/Protest

For all sports, the decisions of the Referees/Umpires will be final and binding, and no protest will be entertained. Therefore, any team leaving the field of play

as a mark of protest and conceding a walkover shall be deemed to have lost the fixture and will be eliminated from the event. Only the remaining teams will be considered participants in that event. Any player of some other pool playing for another pool will be dealt with seriously. The pool for which he/she is playing will be rusticated in that particular event or as per the core team's decision. The umpire present may take an independent decision at his discretion with consent from the participating teams and the Core Team, Inferno '23.

Recommendations

1. Since the closing ceremony takes a lot of time and it is not feasible to hold the Guests of Honour for so long, the upcoming core team should find alternative ways to distribute prizes / conduct the ceremony.
2. The trophies for overall Inferno General Championship Men and Women have been made to be running trophies from this time onwards and the upcoming team should take a note of this and inform the Pools to take care of the trophy. Proper penalization must be employed in case of non-cooperation from the respective pools.
A running trophy creates a sense of legacy among the participants and increases the overall enthusiasm of the community. Also this reduces the costs borne by the council every year.
3. In the long run trophies for every sport should be made running for the similar reasons as mentioned above.
4. Additional equipment for Hockey (goalkeeper kits and sticks) and cricket (bats and batting kits) should be procured to prevent unforeseen circumstances such as this time when the institute teams took the above mentioned equipment for Sportech'23.
5. Kabbadi mats must be procured for future events to prevent unnecessary injuries.
