
3. Updates in Old Sports Gymnasium



Teams participated per sport are:



2. Bicycling Society

1) Pedal for Greener Future 2.0 | A Virtual Cycling Competition Event was organized to celebrate World Bicycling Day and World Environment Day. This one-week event was organized from 3rd June to 9th June of 2023. We

Recommendations:

- 1. Storage and Activity rooms for Clubs and Societies

CPA Reinitiate
